Experience at the festival 2007 in Hungaria:

It was the third time for me to play at the EJMF with 'Gitarriños' and for my husband it was the fourth time with 'Drumbaderos'. So there are many different experiences and a lot of things to compare.

It was always a great experience for the kids (and for us) to travel in a foreign country and see many new things.

There is one very important thing: in Swe/Dan and in Hungaria the places where our concerts took place, haven't been marked on the street, there was not one target to show, that there will be a concert or even a concert room (some times it was even hard for us to find the concert-room). Therefore the audience was nearly empty. For all the young musicians, it was very hard to travel 1000km to play nice music in front of nobody.

The food was fine and very good organised (except for the last day in Budapest, we couldn't even find something to drink or to eat).

The only bad thing was that the 'restaurant' was too far away from the concert places, we had to go by bus.

Our sleeping place was very nice, except the distance from Pécs: we had to drive one hour (four times). So the kids couldn't stay for the evening for their own in Pécs and having fun, because the bus had to drive all together to the dormitory.

We had a good time and enjoyed our concert tour and we hope that there will be many other EJMF in the future.
